

Enrolment and Payment Autumn – Winter 2017-2018

Autumn-Winter term at Young Masters starts the week commencing 4 September 2017.

The new students will start with a Free Taster Class that week. The weekly classes are 90 min long run by a teacher and a teaching assistant. All materials provided.

The monthly fee is £35. 20% Sibling discount applies (£28). Scholarship discounts apply (as per agreement with the parents and availability of funding).

We will also offer school half term workshops. Some of the half-term workshops will not be included in the course fee and have to be booked separately. Workshop bookings have to be made by email or via www.idleartstudio.com/Booking page if applicable. The charge for the workshop will be added to the next monthly invoice.

The invoices will be issued and sent to parents/carers registered email address at the start of each month and payments have to be made by the 15th of each month. If a payment is not received by the end of the month the amended invoice including a late fee of £5 will be sent and failing to pay that immediately the tuition might be refused.

Payment via electronic bank transfer is the preferred payment method at Young Masters. Banking details will be provided on the invoices. Cheques made payable to Idle Art Studio are acceptable, but no cash payments can be taken.

Other Requirements

Any absences or cancellations made by the student cannot be credited or refunded. Lessons cancelled by school will be rearranged for an alternative date.

To preserve continuity of the children's artistic education we encourage children to attend every week. Where parents/carers are not able to bring their children to their respective class, we will accommodate them in one of the other time slots available within the same week.

If the children want to leave Young Masters, one-month cancellation notice will be required.

During the term the artwork will be kept at school for the end of term exhibition and other displays. It will be returned to the children at the start of the following term.

Photography of students will take place and will be used for school publicity and social media unless there is an objection from the parent/guardian.

The children cannot leave school premises without the tutor's agreement. We will need to know who is collecting the children after the class.

Young Masters carries a Public Liability and Risk Assessment for outdoor visits and indoor equipment. No responsibility can be taken for personal belongings. No mobile phones allowed. Suitable clothing required.
