Terms & Conditions of the Exhibition – Competition

1. The theme of the exhibition is **The Christmas Miracle**. Artwork shall be produced by painting means and shall depict the traditional and modern characters on the Nativity scene or any other Christmas Miracle you can imagine happening at that time of the year when everything is possible.
2. Artwork for the competition shall be submitted on one up to A3 size sheet of paper of any density or texture. Only painting, drawing and 2D collage techniques

shall be used. All painting media is allowed including pencils, watercolours, gouache, acrylic paint, oil or soft pastels.

3. Artwork submitted will be divided into age groups 5 – 7, and 8 – 11 years and each group will be moderated separately. Originality and interpretation of the theme shall be taken into account while judging children's work.

4. Each piece of artwork shall be signed by the author and clearly labelled on reverse side of the painting. Artwork shall be submitted with an additional note containing child's full name, age, a name of the primary school or other schooling body involved in child's education and a name and contact details including telephone number and email address of an adult person responsible for the artwork submission. By submitting the artwork the competitors declare that the copyrights and publication of the work is in hands of Idle Art Studio as the organisers of the competition.

5. Submission deadline is **12 December 2014**. Please post your work to Idle Art Studio Ltd Director Virginija Knowles Little Mill Back Lane Idle BD10 8RX or contact her on 07753513869 to arrange collection from your school.

6. The competition and exhibition is free to attend. The artwork submitted to the organisers will be kept and used appropriately for the follow-up displays until February 2015. The competitors will be contacted individually to arrange a return date of their artwork.

7. Anthony Bullock, visual arts coordinator from Bradford Education Future House, will independently moderate the artwork. All participants will receive an invitation to an open day at Thackley Methodist Church, Thackley Road BD10 0RH on **Saturday 20 December 1pm** where the winners will be awarded their prizes and everyone else will receive a certificate of participation.
