These colourful creatures were made by children age five to 11 using techniques taught to them during the Young Masters Spring-Summer 2015 term. The kids used a wide range of materials, colour, but above all, their imagination. The results even include some ambitious (to fly) non-flying things – can you spot them?

Young Masters is a visual art course aimed at a primary school age children. It runs weekly over two terms of 15 weeks starting in March and September each year.

In our classes, children with a diverse range of abilities work alongside, and equally, with other children that love art. Using professional teachers and artists, we do observational drawing, painting, mixed media, sculpture, printing, design and many other artistic techniques. The 'All Tiny Things Flying' display you see here is part of our mixed media work.

We run classes from Bradford City Centre, Guiseley, Thackley and Saltaire. From September we will be opening in Bingley and we continue to look for opportunities to meet needs in the Leeds/Bradford area. At the end of each term, work is exhibited to the public at Kala Sangam Arts Centre in Bradford.

Young Masters is where children discover and develop their natural talent and skills. We are DBS registered and CRB checked. As well as our exhibitions, we run competitions, provide Arts Award certification, and are a part of the Children's University. We are community focused not-for-profit organisation. We do charge fees only to cover the costs of the classes. Our pay is seeing the happy faces of our students and their proud parents.
