This week students will create interesting mixed media landscapes with leading lines, horizons and sky lines as a background for their architectural drawings created the previous week.

We will discuss artists examples and we will have a real life artwork in a classroom to look at and to draw an inspiration from: Sharon's multimedia landscape.

We will make backgrounds using ripped cardboard, tissue paper, maps, newspaper, stuck on a card in layers. Then we will make washes of colour and add previous architectural drawings.

Materials:

- A3 Card
- 2H and 6B pencils / Thin Black Pens / Charcoal
- Drawing Ink / Cocktail Sticks
- Tissue Paper / Newspaper / Cardboard / Maps
- Watercolors / Metallic Acrylics / Flat Emulsion Paint / Oil Pastels
- Glue / Scissors / Architectural Drawings from previous week
- Photographs of artist's work and local buildings
