Ever since Young Masters opened its doors, Idle Art Studio has been supporting their students through offering sibling discounts and SEN discounts and accommodating children with disabilities.

Young Masters has been a successful concept in delivering arts to the youngsters and organising exhibitions and went from strength to strength last year providing benefits to participants and communities involved.

Idle Art Studio has been successful in proposing to involve more children with SEN and disabilities and also to support gifted and talented children at Young Masters through social enterprise programmes.
