

Lesson 7: Impressionist Flowers –

Artist in focus: Georgia O'Keeffe



Artists have used the natural world as a source of inspiration from the earliest of times. This week we will be drawing inspiration from the beautiful blossom that have been appearing all around us over the Easter break.

We will look at Georgia O'Keeffe's painting style to create impressionist images of both delicate and dynamic forms of flora. Georgia O'Keeffe was one of the first female American painters to achieve worldwide acclaim from critics and the general public for exploration of the flower theme that continued throughout her career. We will be blending colours using acrylic paints, and look how contrasting colours make a painting effective and eye-catching.
